All wiring and other electrical equipment must meet all applicable codes. Local codes allow no more than two connections per outlet box for lighting and one connection for power outlets. **No credits will be issued on any electrical service installed as ordered and not used.**

All additional distribution is done by Rossi Expositions' electricians on a time and material basis. Include a floor plan layout of your booth space indicating all outlet locations with measurements and orientation. If a main power drop/delivery location is not indicated on the floor plan, we will deliver to the most convenient location.

208V & HIGHER VOLTAGES: There is a minimum labor charge of (1) hour for installation and 1 hour for removal of all high voltage services. Material charges may apply. If you require services not listed on this form, please call for a custom quote: 510-436-7500. Rossi Expositions must make all high voltage connections and disconnects.

DEDICATED OUTLETS: Dedicated outlets require a 20amp outlet.

24-HOUR SERVICE: Electricity will be turned on within 30 minutes of show opening and off within 30 minutes of show closing, during show days only. If you require power at any other time, please order 24-hour power at double the specified outlet rate.

All outlets will be installed on the floor at the rear of the booth. Should you need to have your outlet(s) placed elsewhere within your booth, please utilize the following grids to mark where you need your outlets placed. All special electrical placements will be billed at time and material.

LABOR

(All special electrical placements are subject to labor charges for installation and dismantle.)

Electrical labor will be billed at \$160 per hour straight time and \$320 per hour overtime (overtime applies to all labor performed other than 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Friday). All outlets that require 208 volt service or motor whips will require electrical labor. Work will start as soon as possible unless otherwise specified. **There is a one-hour minimum for each worker.**

POWER USAGE GUIDE

Any piece of equipment that plugs into a standard wall outlet found in your home or office will require 120-volt power. This includes lights as well as most office equipment and cooking devices.

Determine the amount of power each piece of equipment requires by looking at its rating stamp found on the back or bottom of most equipment where the cord is attached. For larger appliances, the rating can be found inside the door.

The following are power requirements for standard equipment and appliances. This is only a guideline. Please check your specific item to determine power requirement.
